# Subject: “Not Of This World”

## 1) **John 8:23**

And He said to them, “You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world”

## 2) **John 17:14**

“I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.”

## 4) **Elijah**, **1 Kings 19:10,14**, **Romans 11:1-4**, **James 5:17-18**

Not part of King Ahab’s Baal Worship

## 5) **Daniel**, **Daniel 1:8-21**, **3:8-25**, **6:1-28**

In Babylon, Babylon Not In him (separated)

# Subject: “Not Of This World”

Examples in our study series (New Testament):

6) **John the Baptist**, Luke 1:5-17, Luke 7:28-35, Matthew 3:1  
Voice in the Wilderness, Witness (Isaiah 40:3)

7) >> The Lord (The World) <<, John 1:14, John 3:13, John 3:31, John 6:42, John 8:23, John 17:14, Hebrews 2:5-9 (Ps 8:1-9)  
In the World, but Not of This World.

8) **The Disciples**, John 15:19, John 17:14, John 17:16-17, 1 John 2:15-17 (Do not love the world).

9) **The Apostle Paul**, Galatians 1:15, Acts 9:15-16  
Set Apart at birth.

10) **The Church (Body)**, Ephesians 1:4, 2 Timothy 1:9, Colosians 3:1-4,  
**Philippians 3:20-21** (In the world, but not of the world)  
Heavenly Hope and Calling.

# Adam - A Chronological Analysis

- 1) God made the land animals on the 6th day. **Gen 1:24-25**
- 2) God created Adam on the 6th day in His own image. **Gen 1:26-27, Gen 5:1**
- 3) God formed man (Adam) from the dust of the earth and became a living soul (being) **Gen 2:7**, and (earthly) **1 Cor 15:45,47,48**
- 4) God planted a garden eastward in Eden. **Gen 2:8** (known as the paradise)
- 5) God placed Adam in the Garden of Eden. **Gen 2:8**, the paradise, in order to till the ground. **Gen 2:5**

# Adam - A Chronological Analysis

- 6) God's prohibition not to eat from the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil. Consequence would result in death. **Gen 2:16-17**
- 7) God brought the animals to Adam to be named, and Adam's conscious loneliness. **Gen 2:19-20**. No helper and companion for Adam.
- 8) God put Adam in a deep sleep and removes a rib (operation) **Gen 2:21**
- 9) God made (built) the rib into a woman as a helper and companion. **Gen 2:22**. "It is not good that man (Adam) should be alone" **Gen 2:18**
- 10) God brought the woman to Adam and names her "woman" and gives the reasons. **Gen 2:23, 1 Cor 11:8-9**

# Adam - A Chronological Analysis

**11)** God commanded Adam and the woman (Eve) to populate the earth, be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth. **Gen 1:28.**

**12)** God gave Adam and the woman (Eve) dominion over all the earth, to subdue it, and all the wild animals are subjected under them. **Gen 1:26-28.** Adam was crowned with glory and honour, **Ps 8:5**, and in **Ps 8:6** “**Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet:**”. List of animals given in **Ps 8:7-8** Adam the first man was the first king over the earth and Adam was the type of Him who was to come (Christ). Adam, in his sinless state was a type of Christ, **Rom 5:14**, Christ is described as the last Adam by Paul in **1 Cor 15:45**. In Luke’s gospel, the genealogy of Christ, Adam is listed as being the son of God, in **Lk 3:38**.

**13)** The entrance of the serpent in Eden, the temptation to disobey God’s law in Eden as regards to the forbidden fruit: the serpent focuses on the woman, but ignores Adam, in **Gen 3:1-13**.

# Adam - A Chronological Analysis

**14)** Adam and the woman (Eve) eat from the forbidden fruit, the temptation and the fall results in death, the curse and sorrow, **Gen 3:16-19**, and expulsion from Eden

**15)** A promise of a seed of the woman (Christ), which would give victory over the enemy. **Gen 3:15**. A prophetic promise of salvation and the defeat of the seed of the serpent.

**16)** Adam renames the woman and calls her Eve, meaning, “the mother of all living” **Gen 3:20**. Hope of life to come through “the seed of the woman” (salvation) **Gen 3:15**

**17)** God provides tunics of skin to cover Adam and Eve’s nakedness and shame, **Gen 3:21**, an animal needed to be killed to cover their guilt and shame, Adam and Eve witness what death looks like. i.e. The first account of death. (speculation: possibly a sacrifice of a lamb?)

**18)** God acknowledges that man has become as God, as regards to knowing Good and Evil, **Gen 3:22**, differentiation between good and evil.

# Adam - A Chronological Analysis

**19)** God's prohibition now is upon the Tree of Life, **Gen 3:22**

**20)** Adam and Eve's expulsion from the Garden of Eden is to prevent them from eating from the Tree of Life, **Gen 3:23**, the Tree of Life has now become the forbidden fruit.

**21)** Adam was driven out of the Garden of Eden, God places Cherubims outside of Eden to deny access to the Tree of Life. **Gen 3:24**

**22)** Adam and Eve have two sons, Cain and Abel, **Gen 4:1-2**

**23)** The conflict between the seed of the woman, the Godly Seed, and the seed of the serpent, the satanic seed, is clearly seen and manifested in the sad account of Cain and Abel. In **Gen 4:1-5**, Cain murders Abel.



# Adam - A Chronological Analysis

**24)** Adam and Eve have a new son named Seth (appointed) to replace Abel. Adam is aged 130 years of age when Seth is born, **Gen 4:25-26, Gen 5:1-3**, his name Seth, means substitute and appointed, is appointed to replace Abel.

**25)** Adam's newly appointed son, Seth, is described as being in the image of Adam. **Gen 5:3**. Fallen Adam and his years, Adam's lifespan totals 930 years. Seth was born when Adam was 130 years old.

**26)** Adam continued to have other children (sons and daughters), up until the age of 800 years old. **Gen 5:4**

**27)** When Adam is aged 810 years, God's spirit will not strive with Adam, Adam has limited time of 120 years. **Gen 6:3**

**28)** Adam's death at the age of 930 years. **Gen 5:5, 1 Cor 15:22** "... **In Adam All Die ...**"
